At NIN Nigeria, we are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring that any personal information shared with us is handled responsibly, securely, and in compliance with applicable data protection laws. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, and protect personal data in accordance with the Nigeria Data Protection Regulation (NDPR).

By accessing or using this website, you acknowledge and agree to the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. Personal Information We Collect

We collect only the personal information that is necessary to provide NiN-related services and to meet legal or operational requirements. This may include:

- Full legal name
- Email address and phone number
- Date of birth
- National Identification Number (NIN) or NIN reference details
- Government-issued identification information where required
- Basic technical information such as IP address and website usage data

We do not collect unnecessary information, and all data collected has a clear and lawful purpose.

2. How We Use Personal Information

Personal information provided to NIN Nigeria is used strictly for legitimate and defined purposes, including:

- Identity verification and NiN-related processing
- Providing requested services and customer support
- Communicating important service updates or requirements
- Meeting legal, regulatory, or compliance obligations
- Preventing fraud, misuse, or unauthorized access
- Improving the functionality and performance of our website

Personal data is not used for purposes outside of what is reasonably required or permitted by law.

3. Consent

4. Disclosure to Third Parties

We do not sell, rent, or trade personal information.

Personal data may be shared with third parties only where necessary to deliver our services or where required by law. This may include:

- Identity verification or processing partners
- Secure data hosting and storage providers
- Payment processors, where applicable
- Government or regulatory authorities when legally required

All third parties are required to handle personal information confidentially and in line with GDPR requirements. They are permitted to use the data only for the specific purpose for which it was shared.

5. Data Storage and Security

We take appropriate technical, administrative, and organizational measures to protect personal information against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, alteration, or disclosure.

Personal data is stored securely and retained only for as long as necessary to fulfill its intended purpose or to comply with legal requirements. Once no longer required, the information is securely deleted or anonymized.
